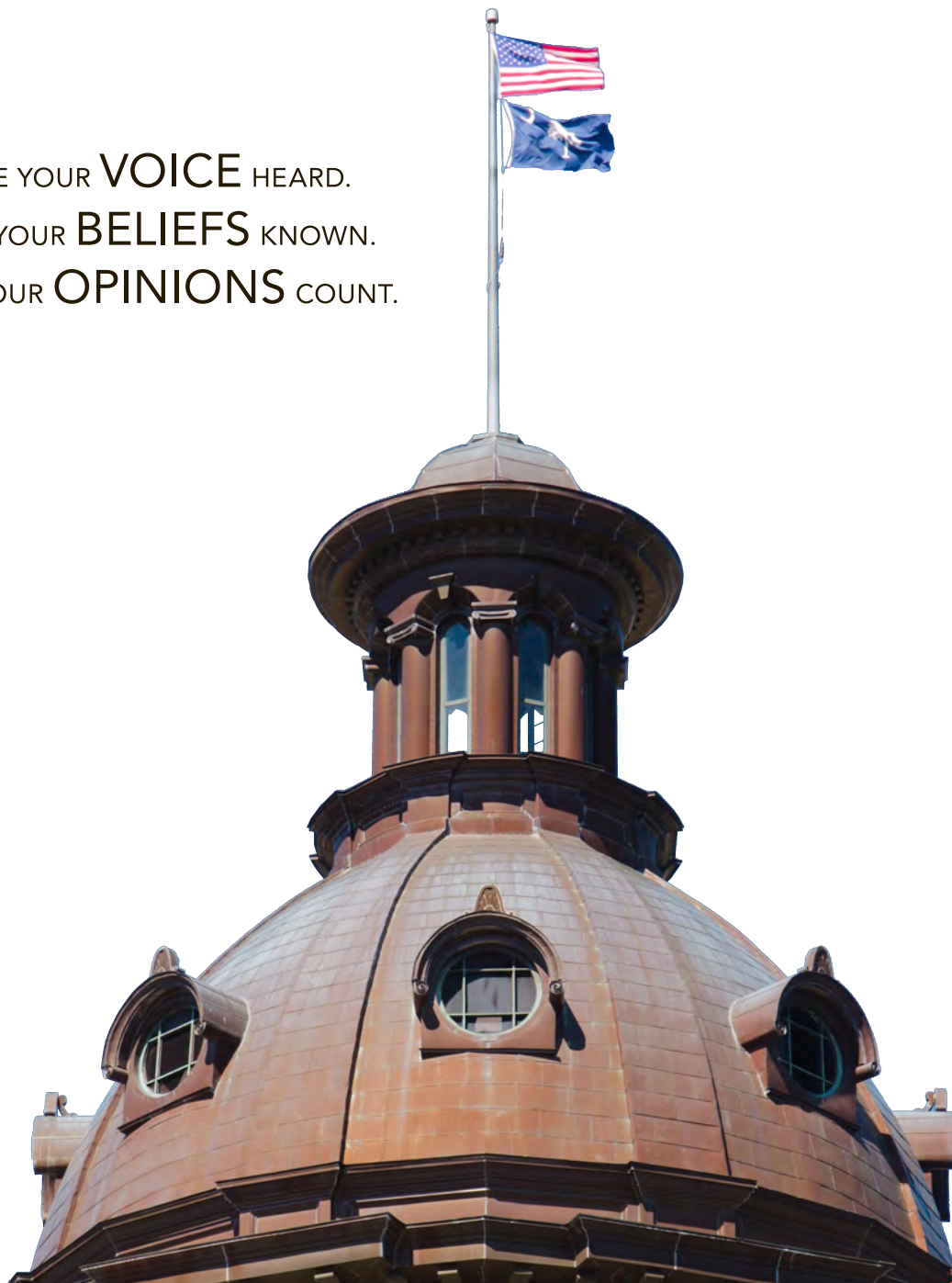

TO VOTE IN THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 6TH,
YOU MUST REGISTER TO VOTE BY OCTOBER 7TH.

Register to vote online at scVOTES.org, or through the My scVOTES app (requires Driver's License or DMV ID). Or download and print an application at scVOTES.org, complete it and return it by mail, fax or email to your county elections office. Mailed applications will be accepted if postmarked by October 9th.

Educate yourself on the candidates and questions. Get a sample ballot at scVOTES.org or through the My scVOTES app.

Don't forget to bring one of the following Photo IDs with you to the polls: SC Driver's License, SC DMV ID Card, SC Voter Registration Card with Photo, Federal Military ID or US Passport. Get a free Photo ID from your county voter registration and elections office, or DMV. If you can't get one of these photo IDs, bring your non-photo voter registration card with you.

Manage your registration and stay up to date on elections by downloading the My scVOTES app from the App Store or Google Play.
